



Winner & Runner-up Expected Duties

(Duties may be subject to change)

Commitment

- Winner and runner up are expected to remain in Tamworth after awards to perform official CLF duties unless granted an exemption.
- Other finalists may leave after judging but are welcome to stay and assist.

Costs

- Travel, accommodation and AELEC fees are the entrant's responsibility.

Ambassador Role

- Act as CLF ambassadors for the following year.
- Promote CLF and the Young Ambassador Quest throughout the year.
- Wear sashes during official duties and when assisting the CLF.

Event Participation

- Attend the following year's Young Ambassador Quest Presentation (exemptions may be granted).
- Assist and encourage entrants in the next year's Quest.
- Assist YAQ Subcommittee during next year's Nutrien Classic.

Promotions and Media

- Provide product reviews and photos of prizes for donors to use for advertising, social media and websites.
- Be available for promotional photographs for CLF and donors (if required).

Flag Duties

- Attend and assist with flag-carrying practice sessions.
- Assist in co-ordinating flag-carrying nights.
- Carry flags if there are insufficient Quest entrants to do so.
- Winner to carry the Australian Flag during the National Anthem on opening night for the following year's Nutrien Classic –
- Winner to provide own horse. *If winner is unavailable the Runner Up will replace.*
